Study on the Improvement Path of the Autonomous Learning Ability of Chinese College Students Majoring in Journalism and Communication under the Network Teaching Environment

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Abstract: With the development of science and technology and the popularization of the Internet, the network teaching environment has become an important part of modern education, and the ecological environment of higher education of journalism and communication in China has also undergone great changes. The network teaching environment emphasizes more that college students should have strong autonomous learning ability and be able to study efficiently, so as to meet the development of journalism and communication disciplines, the development of the industry and lifelong learning in a "learning society". This study aims to analyze the problems of the autonomous learning ability of Chinese students majoring in journalism and communication in the network teaching environment, then it puts forward the path to improve the independent learning ability of college students majoring in journalism and communication.

1. Introduction

1.1. Research background

For example, *Cui Xiaomin* (2018) believes that autonomous learning ability refers to the ability of learners to consciously and actively determine learning goals, make learning plans, choose correct learning methods, monitor their own learning process, and evaluate learning effects^[1]. *Xie Honglian, Peng Weiqiang* (2019) consider autonomous learning ability refers to the learning participants in the process of learning, create their own learning motivation, and to self learning, behavior actively, observe actively, judgment, evaluation and feedback, give full play to the subjective initiative of a way of learning and learning process^[2].

According to this study, self-directed learning ability is the ability of learners to acquire knowledge and skills through active participation and construction, and it is a kind of learning ability with high autonomy. In the process of autonomous learning, learners should have a strong sense of learning,

actively choose the learning content and way, set learning goals, arrange the learning process, and promote the learning and problem solving through active exploration, practice and reflection.

2. Necessary to improve the autonomous learning ability of college students majoring in journalism and communication under the network teaching environment

Journalism and communication major has its own distinctive characteristics, journalism professional students must have higher autonomous learning ability, to understand the development trend of the media industry, emerging technology, market demand and career development opportunities.

2.1. The nature of the discipline determines that the autonomous learning ability of college students of journalism and communication majors must be improved

The subject nature of journalism and communication determines that college students majoring in journalism and communication must actively cultivate and improve their autonomous learning ability in the network teaching environment.

2.1.1. The discipline of journalism and communication covers a wide range of subjects

4. The way to improve the autonomous learning ability of college students majoring in journalism and Communication in the network teaching environment

In the network teaching environment, college students majoring in journalism and communication should take the initiative to seek learning opportunities and resources, and constantly improve their competitiveness and adaptability. To improve the autonomous learning ability of college students majoring in journalism and communication, it can be started from the following aspects:

4.1. Guide students to plan clear learning goals

4.3.6. Keep developing a self-disciplined attitude

Students should adhere to develop the mentality of self-discipline, improve self-efficacy, have the courage to overcome difficulties and setbacks.

4.4. Guide students to master effective learning methods and skills

The Internet provides rich resources and tools for teaching. In the dynamic learning environment of

network teaching, it is particularly important to guide students to effectively use a variety of learning resources, and to cultivate students' ability of autonomous learning and information search.

4.4.1. Guide college students to understand and rationally use the school's online learning platform

4.5.3. Teachers should try to cross interdisciplinary learning
