# A Study on the Application of Chinese Elements in Digital Media Art and Design

In the dynamic design, the algal well pattern is decomposed, copied and processed to make it a distinctive and solid structure, and then recombined to give it a unique visual effect and modern sense. On this basis, combined with the dynamic nature of the building, the treatment of the space layout, scale and reality and falsehood in front of the building and thick, make the visual effect of the building more rich. Interaction design is a higher level of design, which is built on static and dynamic design. In interaction design, each element is carefully dissected first, and then computer technology is used to correct and adjust it, and apply it to the design and development process of the program, in order to truly combine digital media art and traditional elements. Interaction design is often used to complete the interaction between man and machine, for example, the skin design of some input methods extracts classical skin elements from Dunhuang murals and combines them with the editing and development of digitized software to create and display dynamic effects.
