# Research on the Inheritance and Development of "Ansai Waist Drum" Introduced into Guangdong Universities from the Perspective of "Rural Revitalization"

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Abstract: This paper is based on the analysis and evaluation of existing information on Northwest Intangible Cultural Heritage, and takes the Northwest Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage project "Ansai Waist Drum" as an example for in-depth investigation, exploring the opportunities and challenges for the development of Northwest Intangible Cultural Heritage, especially sports intangible cultural heritage projects in Guangdong Province, and striving to broaden the inheritance and development channels of Northwest Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage project "Ansai Waist Drum", aiming to serve the inheritance and development of Northwest Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage projects, and provide some useful ideas for driving rural revitalization in Northwest China. This study concludes that the effective path for introducing the Northwest Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage Project "Ansai Waist Drum" into Guangdong universities is to establish a long-term cooperation mechanism between inheritors and universities, and create a campus cultural brand; We integrate teaching resources and offer characteristic elective courses; Combining online promotion with increased publicity efforts; It utilizes its talent and technological advantages to continue inheriting the intangible cultural heritage of sports.

#### 3. Feasibility of introducing "Ansai Waist Drum" into Guangdong universities from the perspective of "rural revitalization"

### 3.1 Promoting the inheritance of sports intangible cultural heritage in the Northwest region through the human resources of Guangdong universities

The vigorous promotion of rural revitalization cannot be separated from the support of education level in rural areas, which is also driving the progress of education level in rural areas. However, due to the unique geographical location, talent is constantly losing. By entering the relevant homepage, you can browse the introduction content related to the Northwest Traditional Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage Project "Ansai Waist Drum", experience the history and development of the Northwest Traditional Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage Project "Ansai Waist Drum", as well as the unique cultural charm inherited to this day. After browsing, you can make an appointment to participate in related activities of the traditional sports intangible cultural heritage project, such as Ansai Waist Drum Performance, Rural Revitalization Theme Lecture, Intangible Cultural Heritage Inheritance, etc., to immerse yourself in the intangible cultural heritage culture and experience the inheritance and development of the Northwest Intangible Cultural Heritage traditional sports project. Similarly, by clicking on the detailed menu, users can gain a more comprehensive understanding of the historical origins and cultural heritage of related sports projects, which plays a promoting role in serving rural revitalization, sports inheritance and development, and enhances their understanding and interest in Northwest intangible cultural heritage.

## 4. The positive significance of introducing the Northwest sports intangible cultural heritage project "Ansai Waist Drum" into Guangdong universities

#### 4.1 Supporting the development of sports intangible cultural heritage projects in the northwest region

We will hold exhibitions, performances, and competitive competitions to explore innovative Northwest sports intangible cultural heritage activities, meet the diverse experiences of the school, and achieve diversity in the dissemination of intangible cultural heritage. On this basis, by establishing a long-term and solid cooperative relationship between the inheritors of intangible cultural heritage in Northwest China and Guangdong universities, we aim to create a campus characteristic cultural brand, implement the "cross-border linkage" between universities and intangible cultural heritage, and utilize the resources of developed regions in Guangdong to drive the development of Northwest China and promote the innovative development of physical education teaching in Guangdong.

#### 5.2 Integrate teaching resources and offer characteristic elective courses

On the basis of teaching tasks, universities further enrich the diversity of teaching content. This study integrates the Northwest Sports Project into the development and practice of our school's sports elective courses, and further develops the curriculum through the effective integration of the Northwest Sports Intangible Cultural Heritage and traditional disciplines. Based on this, through the construction of WeChat official account, short video account, applet, client and other ways, we will increase the publicity of the northwest intangible cultural heritage project "Ansai Waist Drum", bring the northwest traditional sports into the public's view, and effectively promote everyone to know and love them. By combining online and offline approaches, we can enhance our awareness and understanding while enhancing practical experience. This can also help traditional sports intangible cultural heritage projects in the northwest deeply penetrate people's hearts and help everyone understand a series of national intangible cultural heritage projects, such as the Ansai Waist Drum.

## 5.4 Utilize talent and technological advantages to continue the inheritance of sports intangible cultural heritage
